TSCA Compliance Statement The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published five final rules in the federal register (86 FR 866-932) to regulate five persistent, bio accumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals under Section 6(h) of Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) which prohibit the processing and distribution into commerce. The final rule goes into effect on March 8, 2021. The five regulated PBTs are:

- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1)(PIP (3:1))
- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

Aven International Inc. products to the best of our knowledge comply with all applicable rules or orders under the Toxic Substances Control Act and confirm that we do not intend to contain in our products chemical substances in violation of TSCA or any applicable rules.
